Year ended 31 December 2024

Objectives and Activities

The charity's object is to advance education for the public benefit through the provision of grants of financial assistance to economically disadvantaged current or prospective students of The College of Practical Homeopathy (CPH), supporting them in completing their education and professional qualification in homeopathy.

The Foundation aims to:

- * Provide financial assistance to students facing economic barriers to completing their training;
- * Support students in achieving professional qualifications;
- * Promote educational access and equal opportunity within homeopathy education.

Structure, Governance and Management

The Tony Farley Foundation is governed by its CIO constitution. Trustees are responsible for setting strategic direction, overseeing operations, and ensuring compliance with legal and regulatory obligations.

During 2024, trustees met four times to monitor grant-making, governance, and strategic development.

The trustees are aware of late filings in 2022 and 2023 and are determined to improve systems and best practice. Volunteers have been recruited to support trustees in ensuring compliance and effective administration.

Public Benefit Statement

The trustees have had regard to the Charity Commission’s guidance on public benefit. By providing financial assistance to disadvantaged students, the Foundation continues to deliver public benefit through the advancement of education.

Achievements and Performance

2024 was a year of continued growth for the Foundation. Key achievements include:

- * Held four trustee meetings to monitor operations, governance, and strategic planning.
- * Awarded £2,000 in grant funding on behalf of our Foundation’s first student grantee to support his continued education at CPH.
- * Raised £5,243 in donations to fund grant-making and operational costs.
- * Maintained low operational costs of £297, maximising funds for charitable purposes.
- * Launched the Foundation’s website to increase visibility, attract new donors, and engage prospective trustees.
- * Recruited volunteers to support compliance, governance, and administrative systems.

- Promote educational access and equal opportunity within homeopathy education.

Public benefit statement

Achievements and performance for the year ended 31 December 2023

2023 marked the Foundation's second full financial year since registration. The trustees focused on operational development and took steps to begin delivering its charitable purposes.

Key achievements:

- Held four trustee meetings to review and strengthen governance.
- Developed core policies and administrative procedures.
- Vetted and approved the Foundation's first candidate for a grant.
- Made the first grant payment at the end of the year to support a fully funded postgraduate student at The College of Practical Homeopathy (CPH).

Financial review

During the year, the Foundation received total donations of £401 and made grant payments of £400, leaving a closing balance of £1 at the year end. No other income or expenditure occurred.

Achievements and performance for the year ended 31 December 2022

2022 was the charity's first full financial year since registration. The trustees concentrated on establishing the necessary governance and administrative framework.

Key achievements:

- Held four trustee meetings to plan the charity's development;
- Reviewed governance and administrative requirements for operating as a CIO; - Discussed strategies for trustee recruitment and long-term planning;
- Outlined steps for fundraising and grant-making once operational.

The Foundation did not undertake fundraising or make any grants during 2022 while foundational work continued.

Financial review

The charity had no income and no expenses during the financial year ended 31 December 2022. No funds were held and there was no movement on reserves during the year.

When operations commence, the trustees plan to maintain sufficient reserves to cover administrative costs and support consistent grant-making activity.

Risk management

Key risks identified and addressed in 2022 included:

- Governance and capacity risk: mitigated through plans to recruit additional trustees.
- Operational readiness: addressed by developing procedures for future grant-making.
- Financial control: minimal risk in 2022 as no transactions occurred.

- Launch the Foundation's first grant-making round once funds are available;



- Maintain full compliance with Charity Commission requirements.


