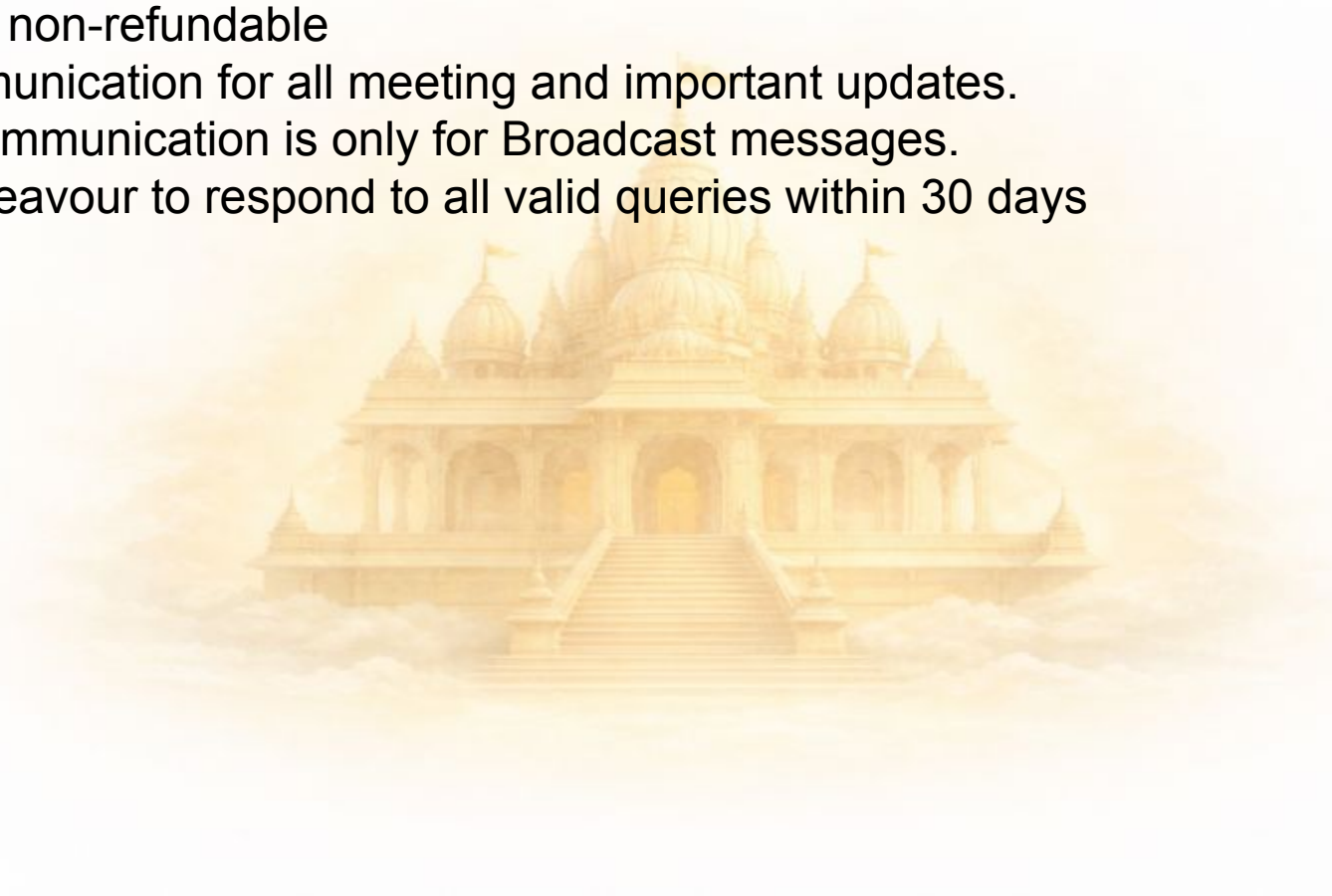

Note 1

The following adjustments relating to prior year transactions have been included within the current year's Receipts & Payments Account. Comparative figures have not been restated.

a) Investment Principal Repayment Misclassified (£5,000)

An amount of £5,000 received in the previous year as a repayment of investment principal had been incorrectly recorded as *donation income*. This resulted in an overstatement of both donation income and investment balances in the prior year. The correction has been presented as an adjustment in the current year's Receipts & Payments Account.

b) Duplication of Event Receipts (£1,908)

Event income of £1,908 was recorded twice in the previous year—once as cash and once as bank—leading to an overstatement of cash and bank balances and event income. The duplicated amount has been adjusted in the current year's Receipts & Payments Account.
