## Annual Report 2024

A quiet year for Bryan's Quest.

In July (2024), The British Library was the venue for a donation be handed over to Bryan's Quest. The donation was in the form of 5 ceramic scale-models of whales. Bryan's Quest paid some of the expenses of the clay model maker, who kindly donated his time for free.

The BBC In Touch radio programme featured the 'Wildlife Within Reach' initiative. Focusing on the life-sized wood carving of a 'Barn Owl', donated by John of The Cornish Wood Carvers Association and the 5 whale ceramics created by Everton.

Due to some significant changes in the personal lives of each of our trustees, the ambitious plans for Bryans Quest, in 2024 have been delayed.

## ANNUAL REPORT: Bryan's Quest

2022 – 2023

Two undergraduates from Falmouth University undertook short internships with Bryans Quest. One intern completed video editing tasks and the other intern focused on narration and audio description. Their work resulted in a series of short videos that will be used to demonstrate and encourage blind people to grow plants and to enjoy a vast range of sensory stimulations, as well as having the satisfaction of germinating seeds, monitoring growth and hopefully eating some nutritious veg and fruit.

Due to some significant challenges in the personal lives of each of our trustees, the ambitious plans for Bryans Quest, in 2023, have been delayed.

The website continues to be maintained and developed to encourage blind and partially sighted people to be given the same opportunities to enjoy and learn about the natural world, as can be experienced by sighted people.

A student of nature filming, shot and edited a video to demonstrate how a blind person negotiates the Cornwall coastal path, independently.

We continue to encourage creative people to make scale models and donate them to Bryan's quest.

Virtually all activities are carried out by the Head Trustee (A. Hesser), with occasional support from the Treasurer. Work commitments of G. Webb have lead to him only being able to fulfil the essential tasks of trusteeship.

- its activities and objectives in the year

In this first year of operation Bryan's Quest has had two objectives to support it's Public benefit aims:

Objective A: to secure sources of funding

Objective B: to recruit volunteers

- its achievements and performance, including reporting on its public benefit

Principle achievements for the year are:

Opening a bank account with Lloyds Bank

Recruiting two temporary student volunteers from Falmouth University  
(each for 8 weeks)

Initial research and development of two projects; 'Wildlife Within Reach (encouraging creative people to make and donate animal models) and Tactile Wildlife Sketches (labelling and distribution)

Developing and maintaining website

On-going filming and narration for YouTube channel

Due to the lack of availability of the trustees, who currently provide the main volunteer force, our ability to advance our public benefits has been severely limited.

The Head Trustee has endeavoured to encourage visually impaired people to engage with nature by several media appearances, such as on BBC Radio Devon and a high profile appearance on national television on BBC's flagship horticultural programme Gardener's World.

- a financial review including any debts and details of your reserves policy (if applicable)

We have no debts.

Bryan's Quest received a £600 grant for 'start-up' enterprises, from the School for Social Entrepreneurs (funded by Lloyds Bank)

A £100 compensation payment was received from Lloyds Bank, due to delayed administration processes when setting up the charity account.

Sales of accessible labels (Way Tags), continued throughout the year, but were low. Generating an income of £285. All stock is donated to Bryan's Quest, free of charge.

Our only expenditure was to maintain the website, costing £118
