A part of this is balancing our fundraising and spending practices accordingly.</p> <p>Across the financial period, income exceeded outgoings to result in a net annual income of £5,149.02 (Gross income = £10,660.48). This is expected to serve us well in delivering our charitable goals long term.</p> <p>Part of this success is owed to our establishment of a Just Giving account to support our (and third parties') fundraising activities. Income from Just Giving donations this period amounted to £6,738.20 - and shall require us to consider how best to utilise this going forward.</p>

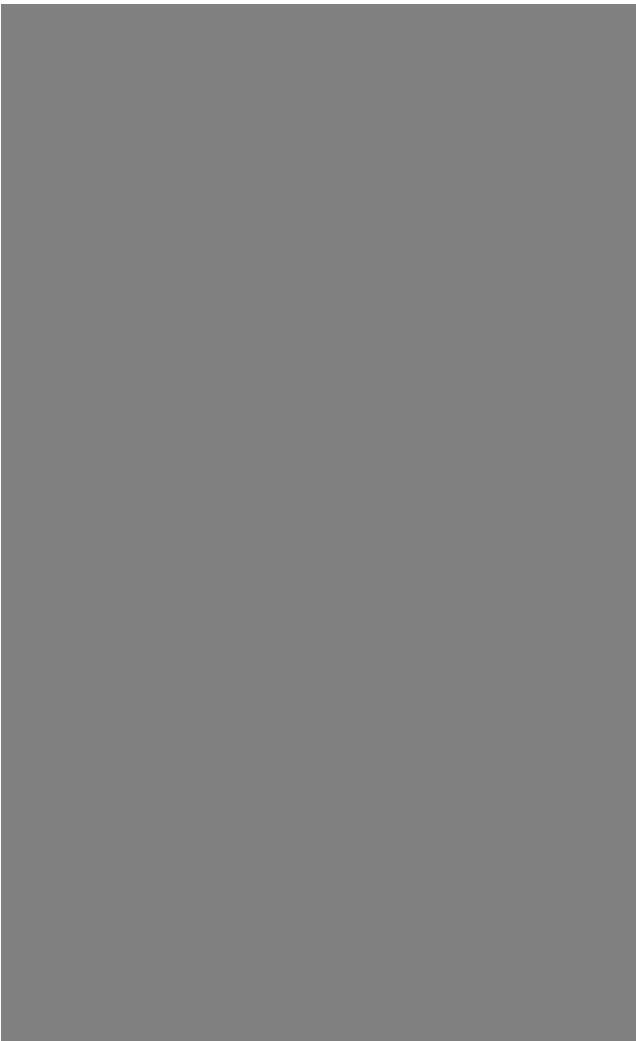




