The objectives of the CIO, as set out in its governing document, are in all cases for the public benefit, to support such charities and charitable purposes as the Trustees from time to time think fit.

The charity furthers its charitable purposes for the public benefit through providing grants to charities.

The trustees have given due regard to the Charity Commission guidance on public benefit when reviewing the charity's aims and objectives and in planning its activities and grant making policy for the year.

ACHIEVEMENTS AND PERFORMANCE

The charity has provided grants of £134,808 during the year (2023: £92,907).

A grant of £50,000 was made to the Screen Academy Foundation. The Screen Academy Foundation is dedicated to advancing the education of pupils at the London Screen Academy, East London Arts & Music and other schools with similar values and with a focus on education in the creative industries.

A grant of £12,500 was made to Willard Carter. The purpose of this grant was to support and further the studies of a very talented, young cellist who came to the foundation asking for help.

A grant of £34,000 was made to the University of Leeds. The purpose of this grant was to fund two undergraduate and two postgraduate students.

A grant of £33,000 was made to the Royal Literary Fund. The charity helps authors or playwrights who are in financial difficulties through grants and pensions.

A grant of £4,808 was made to the Association Lutte Contre Le Sida Tangier. The purpose of this grant was to support the Moroccan NGO that provides HIV prevention, testing, treatment support and human-rights advocacy for people living with or vulnerable to HIV and hepatitis infections.

A grant of £500 was made to Prostate Cancer UK. Prostate Cancer UK fights to help more men survive prostate cancer and enjoy a better quality of life.

The charity has unrestricted reserves of £3,648 at 31 December 2024 (2023: £1,994).





The trustees have given due regard to the Charity Commission guidance on public benefit when reviewing the charity's aims and objectives and in planning its activities and grant making policy for the year.

ACHIEVEMENTS AND PERFORMANCE

The charity has provided grants of £92,907 during the year (2022: £105,000).

A grant of £50,000 was made to the Screen Academy Foundation. The Screen Academy Foundation is dedicated to advancing the education of pupils at the London Screen Academy, East London Arts & Music and other schools with similar values and with a focus on education in the creative industries.

A grant of £20,000 was made to Willard Carter. The purpose of this grant was to support and further the studies of a very talented, young cellist who came to the foundation asking for help.

A grant of £13,500 was made to War Child. War Child protects, educates and stands up for the rights of children in war.

A grant of £5,000 was made to Dr Clare McCaughey. The purpose of this grant was to help a group established in the aftermath of the Marrakech Earthquake in September 2023 by Doctor Clare McCaughey, an English doctor who has been practising for years in Marrakech.

A grant of £3,134 was made to Madison Cox. The purposes of this grant was towards a charitable play by Madison Cox in support of the work of the Association de Lutte Contre Le Sida in Tangier.

A grant of £863 was made to Marrakech Earthquakes Urgence Help. The purposes of this grant was to support an emergency group in the aftermath of the Marrakech Earthquakes in September 2023.

A grant of £410 was made to the British Film Institute. The British Film Institute ensures that film is central to our cultural life, in particular by supporting and nurturing the next generation of filmmakers and audiences.

The trustees have given due regard to the Charity Commission guidance on public benefit when reviewing the charity's aims and objectives and in planning its activities and grant making policy for the year.

ACHIEVEMENTS AND PERFORMANCE

The charity has provided grants of £105,000 during the period.

A grant of £50,000 was made to The Jewish Care in support of Dance for Life. The Jewish Care is a health and social care charity serving the UK Jewish Community in London and the South-East.

A grant of £50,000 was made to The Forward Trust in support of Action on Addiction. The Forward Trust provides a range of services to support individuals, families and communities whose lives are impacted by drug dependency, alcohol and other substance misuse.

A grant of £5,000 was made to the Frazzled Café. The Frazzled Café promotes good health by providing support to persons affected by anxiety, stress and mental health issues through providing a network of private, safe and anonymous spaces for people to talk, connect and share experiences with others.

FINANCIAL REVIEW

The charity received donations of £120,000 during the period. Expenditure during the period was £105,036.

The charity has unrestricted reserves of £14,964 at 31 December 2022.

Apart from the monthly expenses needed for the correct running of the charity, it wasn't the intention of the Trustees to have reserves at the end of the fiscal year. This amount was meant to be allocated as a grant to Mr Willard Carter, but delays in drafting and approving a Foundation grant policy meant that the sums couldn't be released until February 2023.
