1 SEPTEMBER 2022 TO 31 AUGUST 2023

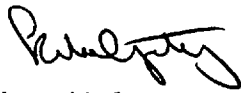
We have had a highly successful year with our fundraising and the children have benefitted from both this and the very welcome Orcina Grant.

The Orcina grant has enabled the PTA to support the school in purchasing equipment and general resources for the children, contributing towards staffing costs for reading, outdoor activities and the setting up of new projects. This funding has enriched and developed the children's curriculum enhancing many aspects of school life.

We have received funding from a local Company to support us in our work and have also received funds from a 40 mile sponsored walk.

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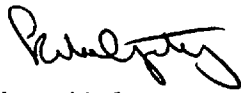
