REPORT OF THE TRUSTEES FOR THE YEAR ENDED 5TH APRIL 2025

The trustees present their report with the financial statements of the charity for the year ended 5th April 2025. The trustees have adopted the provisions of Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2019).

OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

Following the establishment of the trust on 21st December 2021 with the purpose of making grants to alleviate poverty, enhance educational opportunities, increase access to physical and mental health services and reduce social isolation. The trustees confirm that they have continued to refer to the guidance contained in the Charity Commission's general guidance on public benefit when reviewing the trust's aims and objectives and in planning future its activities and considering the grant making policy for its second year.

The trust's website continues to be used for the submission of grant applications. Each application received is reviewed by the trustees with a focus on providing one-off grants for the benefit of individuals whether directly or via an organisation. Over 110 grants were made during the year of varying sizes and the applications received have remained at a steady level due to continuing referrals within the community as well as the detailed information contained on the website including case studies and testimonials. The grants were paid at a consistent rate throughout the year.

The trustees held regular meetings to review and consider the various grant applications received and to agree on those which should receive support whether on a one-off or more ongoing basis. Every grant is considered by the trustees based upon its individual merits and compatability with the trust's objectives.

FINANCIAL REVIEW

The trust's activities were entirely funded by continuing donations made by Mick and Ann Williams. The cash in bank is over £3,500 at the year end but Mick and Ann Williams made further donations after the year end to ensure that any grants would be covered.

The trust does not actively fundraise and seeks to fund its work through the careful management of existing resources and from additional donations from Mick and Ann Williams.

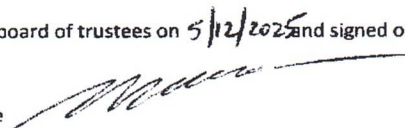

As the trustees, you are responsible for the preparation of the accounts in accordance with the requirements of the Charities Act 2011 ("the Act").

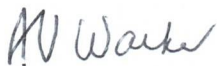

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of preparing the financial statements

The financial statements of the charity, which is a public benefit entity under FRS 102, have been prepared in accordance with the Charities SORP (FRS 102) 'Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2019)', Financial Reporting Standard 102 'The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland' and the Charities Act 2011. The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention, with the exception of investments which are included at market value, as modified by the revaluation of certain assets.

Income

All income is recognised in the Statement of Financial Activities once the charity has entitlement to the funds, it is probable that the income will be received and the amount can be measured reliably.

Expenditure

Liabilities are recognised as expenditure as soon as there is a legal or constructive obligation committing the charity to that expenditure, it is probable that a transfer of economic benefits will be required in settlement and the amount of the obligation can be measured reliably. Expenditure is accounted for on an accruals basis and has been classified under headings that aggregate all costs related to the category. Where costs cannot be directly attributed to particular headings they have been allocated to activities on a basis consistent with the use of resources.

Grants offered subject to conditions which have not been met at the year end are noted as a commitment but not accrued as expenditure.

Taxation

The charity is exempt from tax on its charitable activities.

Fund accounting

Unrestricted funds can be used in accordance with the charitable objectives at the discretion of the trustees.

Restricted funds can only be used for particular restricted purposes within the objects of the charity.

Restrictions arise when specified by the donor and when funds are raised for particular restricted purposes.

The trustees present their report with the financial statements of the charity for the period ended 5th April 2023. The trustees have adopted the provisions of Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2019).

OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

The trust was established on 21st December 2021 with the purpose of making grants to alleviate poverty, enhance educational opportunities, increase access to physical and mental health services and reduce social isolation. The trustees confirm that they have referred to the guidance contained in the Charity Commission's general guidance on public benefit when reviewing the trust's aims and objectives and in planning future activities and setting the grant making policy for the period.

During its first period, the trustees have established a website through which grant applications may be made with focus on providing grants for the benefit of individuals whether directly or via an organisation. It was encouraging to see the number of referrals and applications to the trust steadily growing and almost 100 grants of varying amounts have been made during this initial period. Through referrals within the community and the information and case studies on its website, the stream of grant applications has increased throughout the period to the extent that the number of grants made in the final six months of the period accounted for almost three quarters of the total for the whole period.

The trustees held regular meetings to review and consider the various grant applications received and to agree on those which should receive support whether on a one-off or more ongoing basis. The trust's website is updated to include examples of grants made in order to encourage appropriate applications. Every grant is considered by the trustees based upon its individual merits and compatibility with the trust's objectives.

FINANCIAL REVIEW

The trust's activities were entirely funded by initial donations made by Mick and Ann Williams. The cash in bank is considered to be sufficient to cover new grants for a number of months with further donations expected to be made.

The trust does not actively fundraise and seeks to fund its work through the careful management of existing resources and from additional donations from Mick and Ann Williams.

Mr W.J.D. Griffiths was appointed as an additional trustee on 8th August 2022.

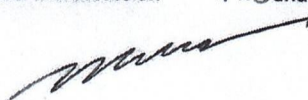

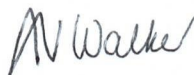
