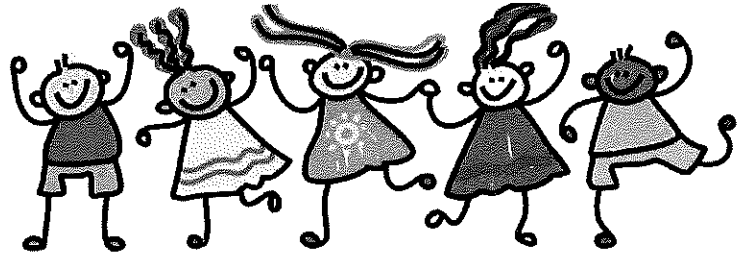



<p>Review of the charity's financial position at the end of the period</p>	<p>Para 1.21</p>	<p>The financial year 22 – 23 has been the most challenging for the service with a fall in service users due to the long term impact of Covid.</p> <p>We ended the year with a loss of £4358, leaving the closing bank balance at £5779, slightly eating into the reserves.</p> <p>However, a financial review and evaluation identified the loss was due to staffing costs and as a result staffing hours have been reduced for 23 – 24 to ensure this loss does not further impact on the reserves.</p>
