Comments on the profit/loss accounts for year ending March 2024.

Whilst we decided not to increase the costs to our riders' families, our payments to the stables for the hire of ponies and use of facilities was increased by the trustees' decision to reflect the considerable increased costs of feed and running costs for Lings Lane stables.

On the positive side, the numbers of regular riders have increased over the year, and

post-pandemic we were able to resume a full timetable, unlike many RDA groups around the country. Our fundraising events and grant applications achieved a significant rise over the previous year, and we are experiencing a high level of financial support from local associations.
