The trustees submit their report and financial statement for The Redeemed Christian Church of God - Revival Assembly Sunderland (The Charity) for the year ended 31 December 2024. The trustees confirm that the annual report and financial statements of the charity have been in accordance with the policies set out in note 1 to the accounts and comply with the charity's trust deed, the Charities Act 2011 and Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice (SORP) applicable in UK and Republic of Ireland published On 16 July 2014

WORKING NAMES

The Redeemed Christian Church of God - Revival Assembly Sunderland also trade under the name RCCG Revival Assembly Sunderland.

OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

The principal object of the charity is the advancement of Christian faith in accordance with the statements of beliefs of the evangelical faith, and the relief of poverty. To achieve its objectives, the charity adopted the following strategies:

Running Christian religious activities comprising of Sunday Services and midweek bible study,
Organising community developments programmes,
Welfare, helps, training and development programmes for individuals,
Supporting other charities and Christian events, and
Convening gathering of Christian tagged Inter-Denominational Christian Gathering.

STRUCTURE, GOVERNANCE AND MANAGEMENT

RCCG Revival Assembly Sunderland is constituted under a Trust Deed dated 1 January 2020. A board of trustees comprising of 3 members provides strategic leadership for the charity, while the Minister in Charge manages the day to day activities of the charity.

POLICIES ADOPTED FOR THE INDUCTION AND TRAINING OF NEW TRUSTEES

The induction process for a newly appointed trustees comprises of an initial meeting with the chair and other trustees, followed by short meetings with the Minister in Charge on the powers and responsibilities of the trustees.

ORGANISATIONAL STRUCTURE AND DECISION MAKING

The trustees meet regularly to manage the affairs of the organisation. The Minister in Charge oversee the spiritual activities of the church.

RISK MANAGEMENT

The Trustees have assessed the major risks to which the charity is exposed, in particular those related to operations and finances of the charity, and are satisfied that systems are in place to mitigate our exposures to major risks.

PUBLIC BENEFITS

The Church's Sunday and mid-week services are open to the general public to build on their Christian faith. Apart from its Church activities, the charity was involved in the following public benefit efforts in the year under review:

- Organising seminars, training programmes and events that encouraged capacity and self development of members of the community
- Holding outreaches in areas of interest to our community. In the year we shared the joy of Christmas with our community by organising a Carol service, we also celebrated the Mothers' Welfare support to members of the community through Food Bank vouchers and food parcels distribution. Households in our community benefitted from hot meals and food parcels given away by the charity.

Our efforts are geared towards supporting the programmes of our local community, promoting cohesion in our community, and impacting the lives of the young people and the elderly.

GRANT MAKING POLICY

The charity supports other charities and missionary that shares its objects the advancement of Christian faith and relief of poverty. The church gives occasional welfare grants to members who are in need.

VOLUNTEERS

The church is grateful for the unstinting efforts of its volunteers who are involved in providing services for the charity. It is estimated that over 1200 hours was provided by volunteers during the year. If this is conservatively valued at £8.50 per hour, the volunteers effort will amount to over £10,200.

REVIEW OF ACTIVITIES

The charity continues to enjoy tremendous growth in its physical and spiritual life during the year, and in the advancement of Christian faith in accordance with the doctrines set out in the Statement of faith contained in our constitution.

RESERVES POLICY

The trustee's policy is to have unrestricted and uncommitted funds (free reserves) to cover 3 to 6 months of resources expended. They feel that this would enable the current activities to continue if there is any significant drop in funding. It would obviously be necessary then to consider how the funding would be replaced or activities changed.

The Trustees are responsible for preparing the annual report and financial statements in accordance with applicable laws and regulations.

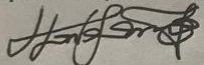

They are also responsible for safeguarding the assets of the company and henceforth taking steps for the prevention and detection of fraud and other irregularities.

set out in the statements below.

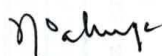
EXAMINER'S STATEMENT

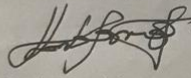

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

(1.1) Basis of preparation of financial statements

These accounts have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective April 2008). The financial statements have been prepared with Statement of Recommended Practice (SORP), "Accounting and Reporting by Charities published in March 2005 and applicable accounting standards.

(1.2) Incoming resources

All incoming resources are included in the statement of financial activities when the charity is legally entitled to the income and the amount can be reasonably quantified with reasonable accuracy.

(1.3) Resources expended

All expenditures are accounted for on an accrual basis. Management and governance costs are cost incurred in connection with administration and compliance with statutory requirement

(1.4) Fixed assets comprises of musical equipment and projectors cost. Depreciation is charged at rates listed below to write off the cost of the assets over their useful lives.
