Structure, governance and management

The charity is constituted as a Charitable Incorporated Organisation (CIO) Foundation, as a body corporate under Part 11 of the Charities Act 2011 on the 22 March 2022. The CIO registered with the Charity Commission on the same day.

Trustees are legally responsible for the governance and management of the charity. Trustees are responsible of setting strategies and policies for ensuring these are implemented.

Risk management - The charity's trustees have considered the major risks to which the charity is exposed and have reviewed potential risks. Systems and procedures have been put in place to manage the risks and to mitigate any adverse outcomes.

Objective and activities

iZinga Assist is an agency that created and provides a digital platform that facilitates the verification, compliance, ratings and assisting of non-profit organisations in sub-Saharan Africa. The aim of the platform is to restore the trust and transparency between international donors and the non-profit sector.

Harnessing the power of modern technology, we have developed a robust method and created a digital platform to evaluate, rate and verify NPOs, aiming to instil confidence in donors in making philanthropic choices. iZinga Assist offers a platform where NPOs can be verified, and donors can discover credible, ethical and transparent organisations. In connecting donors with reputable NPOs, we aim to facilitate the proper allocation of funds to those who truly deserve them.
