Objectives and Activities

Para 1.17	<p>Objectives</p> <p>The object of our Charity is, for the public benefit, to advance the Christian religion in particular, but not limited to, providing spiritual, moral and pastoral care and practical support through the promotion and provision of evangelistic teaching courses, booklets and live events, broadcasting via all types of media outlets, holding of prayer meetings, lectures and public celebration of religious festivals.</p>
Para 1.17 and 1.19 Para 1.20	<p>Community Outreach</p> <p>During July 2022, EME Ministry completed a successful outreach (2 week) missionary trip to Romania. The purpose was networking, evangelism and outreach community support to Romanian Churches. EME provided direct financial support to the Biserica Neemia, Costesti Church in Romania to aid their community food and homelessness projects and to assist with payment of a utility bill after a request for support from the Church. A total of £450 was donated which is included in our <i>Mission to Europe</i> official accounts expenditure.</p> <p>Bursary Support</p> <p>EME Ministry provided bursary support to 3 members and two non-members to attend a Christian Retreat at Ashburnham Place in East Sussex during October 2022. The purpose of our annual retreats is to take members and guests away to a residential and peaceful environment, to seek spiritual upliftment, fellowship and personal counselling support. Every year EME Ministry will seek to arrange financial assistance or completely pay for those who are financially challenged to attend these Christian retreats, which have proven to be immensely worthwhile to people's mental, spiritual and physical well-being.</p> <p>Support to the vulnerable</p> <p>During the financial year EME, supported a vulnerable female asylum seeker who had been made homeless. EME Ministry corporately provided direct financial assistance and temporary lodging within an EME member's household.</p>

	<p>During the financial year, EME Ministry was involved in assisting with food distribution to Food Banks at 3 locations within the East London area. This was an essential outreach program during a time when many in the community were suffering from the devastating cost of living crisis.</p> <p>Supporting Other Charities During the financial year, EME Ministry supported The Hope Café Charity in Romford, Essex which supports the homeless in the community. We held a successful fellowship breakfast raising over £300. There were over 30 members and guests in attendance, and all net funds were donated to the Hope Café Charity.</p>

Para 1.20	<p>Our Continuing Vision We seek to make a difference in people's lives despite being a small fledging Charity.</p> <p>We will continue to participate and initiate community activities as far as our finances allow us to do.</p> <p>Our main vision over the next 2 financial years is to promote and launch a large-scale evangelism event in August 2024 to bring a message of Christian hope to communities that are suffering from many societal ills (i.e. crime, domestic violence, alcoholism and addiction, homelessness and poverty).</p> <p>We will also seek to establish networking partnerships with Churches and affiliates both in the UK and abroad, for the mutual establishment of our core objectives and aims.</p>

Para 1.21	<p>Our financial accounts to the year ending 31st March 2023, reflect a positive start to our new Charity status and the modest increase in bank balances from our starting funds of £6,456 to £8,300.</p> <p>We continue to be vigilant in monitoring our expenses and seeking to strengthen our finances through the promotion of fundraising activities and appeals for donations from volunteers and members.</p>


