Incoming Resources: Major funding came from HAF (£17,000), Thomas Farr (£4,992), and local fundraising contributions.

Expenditure: Most funds were spent on staff costs (£27,225.60), venue hire (£3,335.51), and equipment/resources (£4,424.14).

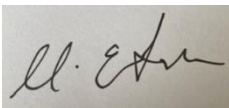

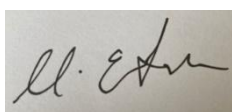
