**STRUCTURE, GOVERNANCE AND MANAGEMENT**

West Street Evangelical Church, a registered charity in England and Wales, is regulated by a set of rules approved in June 2022 registration with the Charity Commission. Responsibility for the management of the activities of West Street is vested in the 4 Trustees and who are elected by the members at the Annual General Meeting held each year.

The charity has 02 employees. One of the trustees has received remuneration from the Charity. The Trustees are asked to maintain regular training on Trustee duties and compliance with charities legislation.

The financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the Statement of Recommended Practice: Accounting & Reporting by Charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS102), and The Charities Act 2011.



**STRUCTURE, GOVERNANCE AND MANAGEMENT**

West Street Evangelical Church, a registered charity in England and Wales, is regulated by a set of rules approved in June 2022 registration with the Charity Commission. Responsibility for the management of the activities of West Street is vested in the 4 Trustee and who are elected by the members at the Annual General Meeting held each year.
