The trustees present their report and the financial statements for the year ended 30 November 2024. The trustees who served during the year and upto the date of this report are set out on page 1.

#### **Structure, governance and management**

Humanity World is registered as a Charitable Incorporated Organisation (CIO) and it was registered as a charity on 13 June 2022.

The charity was established under a constitution, which established the objects and powers of the charitable company.

The directors, who are the trustees in charity law are responsible for the overall management and control of the company working with other persons on an entirely voluntary basis.

Trustees are appointed in accordance with Humanity World constitution. Once appointed, Trustees are given introduction of the charity and information about its objects, Trustees are also given the copy of the constitution and aims and objective, Role description are issued to each trustee and an induction is given setting out the obligations of a trustee. All trustees are issued with copies of the Charity Commission's guidance.

The trustees meet every 3 months.

The trustees actively review the major risk to which the charity is exposed to on a regular basis, in particular those relating to its operations and finances. The system is established to mitigate these.

#### **Objectives and activities for the public benefit**

A. To advance the religion of Islam in the UK, and especially in England for the benefit of the public through the holding of prayer meetings, organising lectures to educate them and through distributing literature on Islamic teachings to enlighten others about these teachings while helping them with their interpretation.

B. The prevention and relief of financial hardship, food poverty & sickness among those suffering from the consequences of natural disasters, wars, economic & social deprivation, or other unfortunate accidents in developing countries, especially in Pakistan through the provision of monetary aid, basic education, medicines, food, clothing as well as shelter in coordination with individuals and local organisations.
