for the Year Ended 31 March 2023

The trustees presents their report with the financial statements of the organisation for the year ended 31 March 2023.

GENERAL INFORMATION

The Church is an unincorporated association, governed by a constitution.

TRUSTEES

The trustees during the year under review are as listed on page 3. Members are elected at the start of the annual year (AGM) by process of nominations and election by the showing of hands.

The trustees board meets quarterly to consider the business of the Church, draft policies and review health and safety. Meetings are also used to review any relevant changes in legislation and social policy that will have direct or indirect impact on the work of the Church.

OBJECTIVES, ORGANISATION AND ACTIVITIES

The objectives of the Church, as set out in the constitution are as follows:

- a) Promotion of social education to young people within the local community using information and positive messages including workshops, group exercises, creative and dramatic arts within Church Schools and local community projects.
- b) The promotion of the Christian Faith through the provision of educational materials, teaching and training of all peoples and groups, the organisation of serminars and conferences aimed at personal awareness, developing self esteem and inner strength through a deeper understanding of the Christian faith.
- c) The provision of counselling and other forms of social, emotional and spiritual support necessary to ensure the development of the whole person who will in turn make an effective positive contribution to their community.
- d) The relief of poverty.
- e) To offer a safe,friendly and neutral environment in local community, where children of separated families can spend time with one or both parents and sometimes other family members

The Church engages in the following activities in order to further these objectives.

- a) Regular monthly meetings.
- b) Educational workshops.
- c) Children Church
- d) Fundraising events within the local community
- e) Support groups for local men, women and young adults.
- f) Weekly bible teaching and prayer meetings
- g) Monthly special prayer mornings

All our events are run and managed by committed volunteers from the local community. The volunteers are of mixed group both in terms of age and gender.

The selfless service and positive contributions of the volunteers is acknowledged and greatly appreciated by the trustees.

ACHIEVEMENTS AND PERFORMANCE DURING THE YEAR

During the year under review, the church applied for charitable status with the Charity Commission and on the 30th June 2022 the church's name was entered on the register of charities in England and Wales under reference number 1199495 meaning that the church is now a fully registered charity.

A committee for “**Social Contract**” is now in place and was setup during the year with sole responsibility of reaching out and engaging with less privileged and others in need, here in the UK and worldwide. This committee were able to reach out by way of donations to major charitable organisations including ASOCIATIA DUMNEZEU LUCREAZA, ASOCIATIA PARINTI SALVATORI, ASICIATIA DARUIM SINE DARUM etc.

Also, within the limited resources the church was able to establish food bank for members of the public, help for lone parents by way of rent payments, clothing for kids.

For families of our members that passed away during the year, the church assisted with reparation of their remains back to their native country, Romania.

As part of efforts to support health and wellbeing of members, the church engaged the services of a Psychologist to offer help and assistance to people with cases of substance abuse.

Relief materials and cash were donated to people affected by the ongoing war in Ukraine

RESERVE POLICY

Given size of the Church in terms of attendance, members of trustee consider that the Church is not in the position to maintain a huge deposit but to hold amount sufficient to pay day to day expenses. In view of this, whatever income the Church generates is applied towards running cost.

FUTURE DEVELOPMENTS

The Church continued to benefit from the generous givings by members however, it is part of the future plans to encourage members to sign up for gift aid as the Church will be able to reclaim tax from the Inland Revenue on amount donated under gift aid. This will enhance the income of the Church.

To meet the increasing demands for support and assistance from members of the local community, the church plan to organise annual health awareness programme during which period health professionals will be invited to offer advice on topical health issues such as, blood pressure, diabetics etc

Efforts will be intensified by leveraging on technology particularly social media, TV and radio broadcast to spread the work of the church across all boundaries of the world.

Awareness and educational programmes and seminars will be organised on topical issues such as, Drama and play group, old age and end of life care, equity release for aged members who are asset rich but cash poor

Wills and Probates, Gift Aid, Career counselling for youths, meet and mingle for singles as a forum to develop relationship, family values and marriage counselling.

Managements will continue to work with other organisations particularly international donor agencies such as WaterAid, Christianaid etc.

Accounting convention

The financial statements have been prepared:

- under the historical cost convention

Fund accounting

Unrestricted funds are general funds which are available for use at the discretion of the trustees in furtherance of the general objectives of the Church and which have not been designated for other purposes.

Restricted funds are funds which are to be used in accordance with specific restrictions imposed by donors or which have been raised by the Church for particular purposes.

The cost of raising and administering such funds are charged against the specific fund. Investment income and gains are allocated to the appropriate fund.

Incoming resources

All incoming resources are included in the statement of financial activities when the Church is legally entitled to the income and the amount can be quantified with reasonable accuracy.

No amounts are included in the financial statements for services donated by volunteers.

Resources expended

All expenditure is accounted for on amount payable basis (Accrual) and has been classified under headings that aggregate all costs related to the category.

Management and administration costs are those incurred in connection with administration of the Church and compliance with constitutional and statutory requirements
