**Objectives and Activities**

The trust owns freehold land detailed on land Registry Title NN348476 being Welford Sibbertoft and Sulby Endowed School, West Street, Welford, Northampton NN6 6HU. The title of which has been vested with the official custodian for charities (reference number 52292).

The trust uses the income (net of expenses) generated by trust property for the following purposes

- The provision of special benefits of any kind not normally provided by the local education authority or school trust for Welford, Sulby and Sibbertoft Endowed School. The provision of these benefits to be agreed by the trustees and the governors of the school.
- The promotion of the education (including social and physical training) of persons under the age of 25 years who are resident in the area of the Ancient Parish of Welford and who are in need of financial assistance
- The provision of grants to not for profit organisations located in the area of the Ancient Parish of Welford who provide services to persons under the age of 25 years to assist in the provision of activities not funded from normal subscriptions which assist in the education and development of said persons.

**Achievements and Performance**

During the year ended 30 September 2025 the trust made grants totalling £2,300 to Welford, Sulby and Sibbertoft Endowed School enabling the school to attend theatre productions, build a link with the Cube theatre at Corby for workshops, training and enabling pupils to perform at the theatre together with a grant to provide group reading material for KS1. The school PTA were also assisted with the purchase of gazebos to be used at events and for pupil shelter at sporting fixtures.

7 (2024 -7) grants were awarded to persons under the age of 25 attending university or other post 18 educational institutions and 5 (2024 -6) grants were award to person undertaking A levels and other post 16 course to assist with the purchase of books and other reference material needed. 1 grant awarded in 2024 was not claimed by a recipient attending 6th form and has been written back in the 2025 accounts.

3 grants were awarded to organisations located in the ancient parish of Welford to support persons under 25 attending residential camps, a trip to Whipsnade zoo and to provide 1st aid training to those participating with the hockey club.

**Financial Review**

The charities capital investments are administered by M&G Investment and are held in a mixture of their Charifund and Charibond Funds. During the year M&G Investments closed their Charibond Funds, the balance held in these funds was transferred to their Charity Multi Asset Fund. The capital funds transferred from Welford Church of England School and School House Trust are held in these investments the income from which is paid into the Charity's current account and used for grant making purposes


The funds invested in Carifunds yielded an income return of 6.12% (2024, 6.04%) over the period and achieved a capital growth of 6.82% (2024, 6.13%)

The funds invested in Caribonds and then the Multi Asset Fund yielded an income return of 4.45% (2024, 4.18%) over the period and achieved a capital growth of 1.02% (2024, 4.34%)

The charity received donations from Springfield Shops in both Welford and Husbands Bosworth totalling £2,013.80 from their sale of carrier bags.







**Objectives and Activities**

The trust owns freehold land detailed on land Registry Title NN348476 being Welford Sibbertoft and Sulby Endowed School, West Street, Welford, Northampton NN6 6HU. The title of which has been vested with the official custodian for charities (reference number 52292).

The trust uses the income (net of expenses) generated by trust property for the following purposes

- The provision of special benefits of any kind not normally provided by the local education authority or school trust for Welford, Sulby and Sibbertoft Endowed School. The provision of these benefits to be agreed by the trustees and the governors of the school.
- The promotion of the education (including social and physical training) of persons under the age of 25 years who are resident in the area of the Ancient Parish of Welford and who are in need of financial assistance
- The provision of grants to not for profit organisations located in the area of the Ancient Parish of Welford who provide services to persons under the age of 25 years to assist in the provision of activities not funded from normal subscriptions which assist in the education and development of said persons.

**Achievements and Performance**

During the period 8 July 2022 to 30 September 2023 the trust made grants totalling £3,674 to Welford, Sulby and Sibbertoft Endowed School enabling the school to attend theatre productions, to have an author to visit the school and support pupils attending residential. The school PTA were also assisted with the purchase of dictionaries and magazine subscriptions.

20 grants were awarded to persons under the age of 25 attending university or other post 18 educational institutions and 10 grants were award to person undertaking A levels and other post 16 course to assist with the purchase of books and other reference material needed

2 grants were awarded to organisations located in the ancient parish of Welford to support persons under 25 attending residential camps and participating in the walk to school week.

**Financial Review**

The charities capital investments are administered by M&G Investment and are held in a mixture of their Charifund and Charibond Funds. The capital funds transferred from Welford Church of England School and School House Trust are held in these investments the income from which is paid into the Charity's current account and used for grant making purposes. The funds invested in Carifunds yielded an annual return of 6.16% with the charibond funds yielding a return of 3.43%




