Objectives and Activities

The charity's objective is:

"To advance such charitable purposes for the benefit of the local community as the trustees see fit, primarily by making grants to other charities and not-for-profit organisations operating in Llanidloes and surrounding areas."

Our activities this year focused on:

- Raising funds from local donors and supporters
- Identifying and verifying suitable local causes
- Distributing 100% of raised funds to registered charities and grassroots groups working to alleviate poverty, support mental health, improve community wellbeing, and enhance access to education and services.

Achievements and Performance

In the 2023–2024 financial year, we:

- Received £231,998 through donations.
- Made grants, ranging from £1000 to £38,573.98, to local charities including:

- Llanidloes Christmas Lights
- Llanidloes Football Club
- Llanidloes Youth Club
- Minerva Arts Centre
- Facilitated direct feedback and follow-up reporting from recipients to ensure accountability and impact

We are proud that no unavoidable costs were incurred and donations were distributed wholly to local organisations thanks to our volunteer-only operating model.

Financial Review

The charity had an income of £231,998, all of which came from voluntary donations and events. Total expenditure was £163,963, of which:

- £163,233 was distributed in grants
- £730 was spent on unavoidable costs (e.g. website hosting, plaques)

We maintain minimal reserves of £5000 to cover operational contingencies. The charity does not hold investments or employ staff.

We continue to operate on a zero-salary, low-overhead model, ensuring maximum impact for local causes.

Reserves Policy

The trustees aim to retain a general reserve of at least £5000 to cover any unexpected administrative costs or emergency funding needs. Any surplus income is distributed at the next quarterly review.

Public Benefit Statement

The trustees confirm they have complied with the duty in section 17 of the Charities Act 2011 to have due regard to the Charity Commission's guidance on public benefit. All activities directly benefit the local community through financial support to organisations delivering public services and social support.

Plans for the Future

In 2024–2025, the charity will:

- Continue to ensure 100% of monies received goes to good causes and supports the local community as is the purpose of this charity.

Independent Examiner's Report on the Accounts

I report on the accounts of the charity for the year ended 30 September 2024, which are set out in the accompanying statements.

Respective responsibilities of trustees and examiner

The charity's trustees are responsible for the preparation of the accounts. The charity's trustees consider that an audit is not required for this year under section 144(2) of the Charities Act 2011 (the Act), and that an independent examination is needed.
