The Cave Rescue Organisation (CRO) was established in 1935 as a Cave Rescue team covering the main caving areas of the Yorkshire Dales. In 1960 the team also became a full Mountain Rescue team but continued with our original name (which admittedly does cause a bit of confusion). CRO are full voting members of both the British Cave Rescue Council (BCRC) and Mountain Rescue England and Wales (MREW).

The team is based in Clapham, North Yorkshire, and responds to Cave and Mountain Rescue incidents in the Three Peaks and Malhamdale areas of the Yorkshire Dales. The team is composed and run entirely by volunteers.
