ORIGINALLY SUGGESTED in July 2022, as the Lady Chapel neared its splendid re-ordering, the idea of a charity to give financial support for its upkeep was formally agreed in October.

The registration process with the Charity Commission was surprisingly quick, and on Old St Thomas's Day 2022 we became a fully fledged charity. Opening a bank account has, by contrast, been achingly slow. The hurdles, set-backs, mistakes, failures of banking software, and more besides, have succeeded each other as the months have passed. At the time of our AGM on 23.01.24, we do appear to be nearing the end-game.
