CARDIAC ARRESTS (WHAT) IN THE MINEHEAD AREA (WHERE) FOR ANY MEMBER OF THE PUBLIC WHO HAS SUFFERED A SUSPECTED CARDIAC ARREST, (WHO) IN PARTICULAR BUT NOT EXCLUSIVELY BY, FUNDRAISING, PROVIDING INFORMATION, ADVICE AND MAKING GRANTS TO HOST LOCATIONS, IN ORDER TO ESTABLISH A NETWORK OF SUSTAINABLE PUBLIC ACCESS AUTOMATIC EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATORS (AED?S) THAT CAN BE USED TO GIVE VICTIMS LIFESAVING FIRST AID AND DRAMATICALLY INCREASE THE CHANCE OF THEIR SURVIVAL AND TO ENSURE THE PUBLIC ACCESS DEFIBRILLATORS ARE MAINTAINED ON THE NATIONAL DEFIB DATABASE THAT IS ACCESSIBLE TO THE AMBULANCE SERVICES NATIONWIDE (HOW). ?SUSTAINABLE? ASSESSMENT, BASIC LIFE SUPPORT (CPR) AND HOW TO USE AN AUTOMATIC EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATOR IN ACCORDANCE WITH CURRENT NATIONAL AND INTERNATIONAL GUIDANCE, (WHAT) FOR ANYONE OVER THE AGE OF 7 YEARS.(WHO) THIS KNOWLEDGE, UNDERSTANDING AND ASSOCIATED SKILLS COULD THEN BE USED BY THE RECIPIENT IN ANY PART OF THE WORLD (WHERE).
