

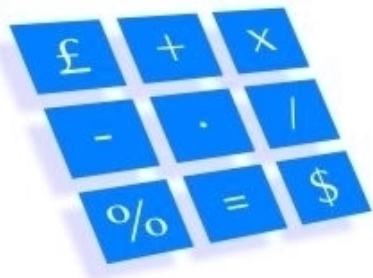

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Independent Examiner's Report to the Trustees of KidZone @ Christ Church Primary School, Cheltenham
