1. Introduction

TARA CARE UK exists to relieve sickness and preserve health among disadvantaged communities in India, with a particular focus on eye care. The charity provides financial assistance for medical treatment for people suffering from blindness and other eye conditions and supports the provision of eye care facilities and equipment to improve access to treatment.

This Trustees' Annual Report outlines the charity's activities, governance, and financial position for the period from 1 April 2024 to 31 March 2025.

2. Trustee Statement

The trustees confirm that they have acted in accordance with their duties under charity law and have ensured that TARA CARE UK continued to operate in support of its charitable objectives throughout the reporting period.

During the year, the trustees focused on maintaining effective oversight of the charity, safeguarding its resources, and ensuring that funds held were managed prudently and in line with the charity's purposes.

3. Objectives and Activities

Mission and Purpose:

TARA CARE UK's mission is to support poor and vulnerable individuals in India by enabling access to essential eye care services, including cataract surgery and related treatments, and by supporting eye care infrastructure. The charity also seeks to support the welfare of elderly individuals living in poverty.

Activities During the Year:

During the reporting period, the charity's activities focused primarily on maintaining relationships with partner organisations, monitoring previously supported initiatives, and planning future programmes.

4. Review of Achievements and Public Benefit

The trustees are satisfied that the charity continued to deliver public benefit by preserving funds for future eye care and elderly support initiatives.

5. Financial Review

The charity adopted a cautious financial approach during the year, with limited expenditure and funds retained for future charitable activities.
