Para 1.20	<p>The charity has arranged various social gatherings in its first year of registration for people in the Marden community living with Dementia, along with people caring for them too.</p> <p>There have been musical gatherings at the local village club with refreshments provided, there have been entertainers providing Dementia friendly sessions in the village in our first year of registration. We also held a Christmas party. We helped raise the awareness of Dementia and just how hard it can be to live with such a diagnosis by providing a Dementia information bus in the village offering free Dementia 'experiences' to anyone in the village who wanted in our first year. We arranged a successful fundraising quiz night in the village pub. We have also worked closely with our GP practice to support people who have received a diagnosis of Dementia, and also with our public library to promote awareness of how people can be supported to live better with a diagnosis. We have also received support from our parish church.</p>
