| A description of the principal risks facing the charity                         | Para 1.46 | <p>We currently have just around 40 dogs in our care awaiting their forever home and in the past year, we successfully rehomed 56 dogs. However, in 'normal times', this figure would usually be in the region of 110-120 and so our kennelling costs are still elevated.</p> <p>There have been several underlying reasons causing this fall, including the extraordinary and unprecedented rise in running costs throughout the UK. Furthermore, due to the cost-of-living crisis, owners are having to give up their dogs due to not being able to afford their upkeep, coupled with a decline in the level of people seeking to adopt a dog when compared with the 'ordinary times'.</p> <p>We will always remain totally committed to saving dogs and, with the dedication of our volunteers, we are working extremely hard, pulling out all the stops to fundraise as much as we can, in order that we can keep being there for our incredible hounds.</p> |






