## **April 2024**

In April we conducted **24 outreaches** across Birmingham, Essex, London and Milton Keynes, sharing the Christian message with **749 individuals**, of whom **104** expressed a desire to begin the Christian faith. Individuals were encouraged to connect with a local church and begin Bible reading and prayer.

Alongside ongoing outreach activity, we undertook significant preparation for our Gospel Campaign scheduled for 31 May–2 June. This work included contacting churches, arranging in-person visits, and presenting the event vision at Sunday services throughout the month.

We also hosted a **CfaN Evangelism Workshop** at Mount Zion Community Church, spoke at a Youth Conference hosted by RCCG JCC, ministered at Good News Christian Centre in Walsall, and trained students at the CfaN School of Evangelism. Preparations continued for volunteer mobilisation and event delivery.

## **May 2024**

Across **33 outreaches**, we shared the gospel with **1,781 individuals**, with **268** making decisions to begin the Christian faith.

We also prepared for our young-adult evangelism training event, *The Charge*, continued to engage churches through calls and Sunday visits,

and provided **three online training sessions** for churches involved in new-believer follow-up.

We partnered with Walking Like Jesus Ministries at their Trafalgar Square event, where we shared testimony and engaged the public in one-to-one conversations.

We held **two six-hour prayer gatherings**, one online and one in person, and were interviewed on **BBC WM Radio** to share information about the upcoming Gospel Campaign.

Our three-day “**Nights of Freedom**” event in Handsworth Park drew **1,232 attendees**, with **94 individuals** making decisions to become Christians.

## **June 2024**

In June we shared the Christian message with **402 individuals** across **12 outreaches**, seeing **105** respond positively.

We held an evangelism training conference in Leeds, concluding with an outreach engaging **154 individuals** and resulting in **54 decisions**.

Additionally, we served as instructors at the CfaN FireCamp in Ilford and partnered with Castlegate Church for a three-day mission in Telford, combining street outreach and youth ministry.

## **July 2024**

During July, **22 outreaches** engaged **393 individuals**, with **51** indicating a decision to begin the Christian faith.

We provided teaching and coaching for the **CfaN FireCamp in Australia**, including practical evangelism assessment. We later served as coaches in the **Isle of Wight**, training churches before supporting a local outreach event.

## **August 2024**

In August we reached **1,296 individuals** across **39 outreaches**, with **159** responding to the Christian message. A major portion of this activity formed part of a **three-week city gospel mission** (32 outreaches).

We conducted two **Mass Outreaches** in Clacton-on-Sea and Brighton, collectively sharing the Christian message with **425 individuals**, with **56** making decisions. We also supported a town-centre mission with Castlegate Church.

## **September 2024**

Across **11 outreaches**, we shared the Christian message with **474 individuals**, with **60** making decisions.

A Mass Outreach in Milton Keynes engaged **290 individuals**, with **46** responding positively.

Preparations began for a **2025 summer Gospel Campaign**, including initial engagement with the local council regarding Summerfield Park and outreach to churches to invite participation.

### **October 2024**

In October we shared the Christian message with **641 individuals**, of whom **60** responded.

We also delivered a **12-hour outreach initiative** comprising four 3-hour sessions, enabling new participants to be trained and deployed throughout the day. This initiative engaged **340 individuals**, with **29** responses.

Church onboarding for the 2025 campaign continued through calls and administrative support.

### **November 2024**

We conducted Mass Outreaches in **Birmingham, London and Coventry**, contributing to a total reach of **679 individuals**, with **64** decisions.

A **six-hour online prayer gathering** was held for volunteers and partner churches.

We were invited to teach on evangelism at KAN Coventry.

## **December 2024**

Across **12 outreaches**, we shared the Christian message with **533 individuals**, with **64** making decisions.

A Mass Outreach in Chelmsford (Essex) engaged **145 individuals**, with **36** responding.

Across the 2024 calendar year, we shared the Christian message with **9,490 individuals**, with **1,525** making decisions to become Christians, through **232 outreaches**.

Church mobilisation for the 2025 campaign continued, including vision sharing at House of Praise RCCG, where volunteers were registered for future involvement.

## **January 2025**

In January, **18 outreaches** engaged **228 individuals**, with **27** responding positively.

We continued to mobilise churches for the summer campaign and scheduled multiple vision-presentation Sundays.

Work continued on an evangelism book intended to support Christians in outreach.

We also contributed as a panellist at the **CfaN Reunion Retreat** and began producing promotional media for the upcoming Gospel Campaign.

## **February 2025**

Preparations for the summer Gospel Campaign continued, including church presentations and a **CfaN evangelism workshop**.

A Mass Outreach in Leicester engaged **181 individuals**, with **42** deciding to become Christians.

Across the month, a total of **437 individuals** were engaged, with **67** responding.

A new weekly outreach location was launched in Wolverhampton.

We also appeared on the Christian YouTube channel *Anesu's Kitchen* to discuss evangelism.

## **March 2025**

Outreach activity continued throughout Birmingham, including a Mass Outreach engaging **103 individuals**, with **22** responding.

We were invited to speak at *Co-missioned* in London and contributed to a Q&A panel.

A Mass Outreach in Liverpool engaged **264 individuals**, with **59** making decisions.

We also launched a public interview initiative aimed at raising awareness of the lack of basic Christian knowledge in the UK and equipping Christians to communicate their faith effectively. These videos have received considerable engagement and positive feedback.

### **Total Reach for the Year (April 2024 – March 2025)**

- **Total individuals reached: 10,522**
- **Total individuals who responded to become Christians: 1,700**
- **Total outreaches conducted: 232 in 2024 + ongoing activity in 2025**



#### **CHARITY'S ACTIVITIES THROUGHOUT THE YEAR :**

##### **April 2023**

In April, we hosted an evangelism training conference in Walthamstow, East London, where we trained approximately 100 participants in evangelism techniques. The conference included a practical session where attendees put their learning into action on the streets. At the end of the day, we engaged with 164 individuals about Jesus and the Gospels, resulting in 44 commitments to Christ.

Throughout April, we conducted multiple outreaches in Birmingham, Dudley, and Brighton. These efforts included both team-led initiatives and solo missions where I personally engaged with people about Jesus. Additionally, I was invited to provide training for Christ for all Nations

in Brighton. There, we took learners to the city centre to practice evangelism, which led to 34 one-on-one conversations and 5 commitments to Christ.

In total, April saw us share the Gospel with 382 people, resulting in 93 decisions for Jesus. Through social media, we reached 29,434 viewers with content designed to encourage evangelism, showcase our outreach efforts, and teach Biblical principles.

### **May 2023**

In May, we expanded our outreach efforts, visiting various locations in Birmingham, Dudley, and London with different teams. We engaged in one-on-one conversations with 265 people, which resulted in 44 decisions to follow Jesus. Through our social media outreach, we reached 144,800 viewers, continuing to inspire and educate on evangelism.

### **June 2023**

June was a busy month with 11 outreaches and an invitation to assist a ministry in Germany. There, we helped equip the church for evangelism and conducted three additional outreaches in the city. Back in the UK, we hosted a second evangelism training conference on Oxford Street, Central London, training around 200 participants. After the training, we held a Jesus celebration at Oxford Circus station, during which 560 people heard the Gospel, leading to 100 decisions for Christ.

Overall, in June, we reached 851 people, with 141 decisions for Jesus, and through our social media efforts, we reached 857,444 people.

### **July 2023**

In July, we conducted 8 outreaches in Birmingham, London, and Dudley, engaging with 325 people and seeing 21 of them respond to the Gospel. We also launched our first evangelism training course, which spanned 16 hours of teaching and Q&A, with 57 students registering. The course featured guest teachers and received positive feedback from participants. Our social media outreach reached 66,612 viewers, continuing to spread the message.

### **August 2023**

August saw us holding 7 outreaches in Birmingham, Dudley, and London, during which we spoke to 269 people and saw 30 decisions for Christ. Our social media efforts reached 137,487 viewers, continuing to encourage and teach on evangelism.

## **September 2023**

In September, we launched a new course focused on evangelism and theology, consisting of 16 hours of teaching sessions and Q&A. We provided additional training for those interested and travelled to Leicester to train young people in evangelism. This training was followed by practical street outreach. I also spent a week in South Africa, serving as a coach and mentor at Christ for all Nations' School of Evangelism, assisting students in their evangelistic outreach.

During September, we shared the Gospel with 401 people, leading to 178 decisions for Christ.

## **October 2023**

The first 12 days of October were spent in South Africa, where I continued my work with CfaN, serving as a coach and mentor to students at the Fire Camp. Upon returning to the UK, I resumed weekly outreaches in Birmingham and organised a Mass Outreach in the city, which concluded with a Jesus Celebration. In October, we shared the Gospel with 289 people, resulting in 25 decisions for Christ.

## **November 2023**

In November, we increased our outreach efforts to three days per week and organised a breakfast for church leaders in preparation for our 2024 Birmingham Gospel Campaign. This was followed by another Mass Outreach in Birmingham, which gathered 50-60 participants to share the Gospel, leading to 68 commitments to Christ from 337 people who heard the message.

## **December 2023**

December was a month of continued outreach in Birmingham, with new teams launched in London and Milton Keynes, holding several outreaches per week. We also focused on research to build a church database for the upcoming Birmingham Gospel Campaign. In December, our team shared the Gospel with 519 people, resulting in 83 decisions for Christ.

## **January 2024**

In January, we continued our outreach efforts across Birmingham, London, and Milton Keynes, and organised two Mass Outreaches in Birmingham and Leicester Square, London. We conducted 25 outreaches in total, sharing the Gospel with 1,238 people and seeing 197 commitments to Christ. We also began planning for a Mass Outreach in Croydon and launched online meetings for new believers to support their spiritual growth and connect them to local churches.

## **February 2024**

February saw us conducting 17 outreaches, including a Mass Outreach in Croydon, where 677 people heard the Gospel and 72 made decisions for Christ. We continued building our church database for the Birmingham Gospel Campaign and partnered with churches in Birmingham to share the campaign's vision and recruit volunteers. Additionally, I assisted CfaN with a Fire Camp in Wales, training students in evangelism.

## **March 2024**

In March, we launched a fourth outreach location in Essex and continued our efforts in Birmingham, London, and Milton Keynes. We also assisted CfaN with a Fire Camp in Manchester, followed by two days of evangelism training. We partnered with a church in Milton Keynes for an evangelism training session, followed by outreach. The month concluded with a training conference in Birmingham, which had a positive impact on attendees. In March, we shared the Gospel with 889 people, leading to 175 commitments to Christ.

## **Summary**

Through all our initiatives from April 2023 to March 2024, we shared the Christian faith with 6,462 people through one-on-one conversations, resulting in 606 decisions to follow Jesus.

## **Financial Spending**

The finances for Rise for Christ International were primarily used to support Jason Smith in organising, planning, and executing tasks to achieve our charity's goals. Other costs included travel and parking for community outreach, equipment purchases, and hosting conferences, which involved venue hire, hospitality for speakers and volunteers, and covering transport costs for guest speakers.
