The Oasis Foundation is a **Charitable Incorporated Organisation (CIO)** governed by a CIO constitution and registered with the Charity Commission for England and Wales.

2. Objectives and Activities

Objectives

The Oasis Foundation exists to:

- Advance the Christian faith by raising public awareness and understanding of religious beliefs and practices, while carrying out missionary and outreach work
- Alleviate poverty and provide relief to the needs of children and young people through grants and the provision of items designed to improve their conditions of life, such as clothing and food.

Activities

During the reporting period, the charity remained in a preparatory and organisational phase. No formal charitable programmes or financial transactions were carried out through the registered charity structure during this time.



3. Public Benefit

The trustees confirm that they have complied with their duty under section 17 of the Charities Act 2011 to have due regard to the Charity Commission's guidance on public benefit.

Although the charity did not undertake financial activity during this period, its purposes remain for the public benefit, and future activities are intended to further these charitable aims.

4. Financial Review

During the financial period ended 5 April 2025:

- The charity **received no income**
- The charity **incurred no expenditure**
- The charity held **no assets or liabilities**

The trustees therefore consider the charity to have been **dormant for financial purposes** during this period.

5. Reserves Policy

As the charity did not receive or hold funds during this period, no reserves were held. The trustees will establish an appropriate reserves policy once the charity begins active financial operations.

6. Structure, Governance and Management

The charity is governed by its CIO constitution. Trustees are appointed in accordance with the governing document.

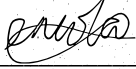
8. Plans for Future Periods
