The change of use will be to meet the needs of the local people and to provide a hub for educational and spiritual development.</p> <p>The charity also intends to host coffee mornings at the centre where people can meet and socialise. This is especially important for the elderly within the community who are living in isolation as it will provide a safe environment where they can socialise and get necessary support if required.</p> <p>The charity would also like to set up a food bank to support those on low income, the elderly and single parent families struggling due to the rising costs of living.</p> <p>In addition, for educational development the centre hopes to provide homework clubs, youth activities and other workshops for the benefit of local people.</p>
