3. Achievements and Performance (2024 – 2025)

Throughout the year, Global Light Ministries continued to grow in fellowship, outreach, and community engagement.

Spiritual and Community Activities

January 2025 – Annual Prayer and Fasting:

We began the year with a two-week period of prayer and fasting (10–26 January 2025), held via Zoom. Attendance was strong, with active participation and spiritual renewal among members.

April 2025 – Easter Conference:

Held at Cliffe Memorial Hall from 18–20 April 2025. The conference was well attended and provided a valuable opportunity for believers of all ages and denominations to connect, worship, and network.

April 2025 – Youth Outing to Rock UK:

A group of 35 young people enjoyed a day of team-building activities, including lower ropes, ball games, and group discussions on youth-related topics.

June 2025 – Visit to Buckland Farm, Rochester:

Youth members visited Buckland Farm on 28 June 2025 to learn about farm life. They engaged with animals, explored the fields, and were guided on a farm tour by Heather and her father.

June 2025 – High Praise Night:

A lively evening of worship and praise attended by approximately 60–70 people of all ages.

July 2025 – Baptism Service:

Six members were baptised on 28 July 2025. Each received a baptism certificate as a token of their spiritual commitment.

August 2025 – Youth Ice-Skating Trip, Rochester:

Young people enjoyed a day of ice-skating, ball games, and a BBQ. Group discussions covered practical topics such as budgeting, debt management, relationships, dating, and courtship.

Weekly Bible Study: Every Friday, 20:00–21:00 (Zoom).

Collaborative Projects

GLM is a church based in Kent (Cliffe Village)

Our Aims

1. To reach people with the good news of Jesus Christ.
2. To help people of all ages and backgrounds to understand the Christian faith.
3. To be a community of believers who intend to help each other in everyday struggles of life.
4. To support those that are vulnerable; the poor, disabled and disadvantaged in society.
5. To encourage parents to find time for their children and take them out to social activities.
6. To have a set of beliefs and values we live with as part of the Christian community.
7. To help and support those in bereavement or just struggling to cope with life.
8. To raise our children in a safe space, encouraging them to have Christian values and beliefs.
9. To support the local community where possible, giving recourse to live by.
10. To be an agent of peace, friendship and encouraging integration of communities.

Our achievements of 2024:

- Our normal regular Sunday Services have continued to run smoothly
- Our membership has averaged at around 30 people per service. In addition to this we have over 232 followers on Facebook. Our audience has increased to over a thousand on social media.
- Virtual Bible studies and prayer meetings run on Mondays and Fridays over Zoom.

- Youth trip to Thorpe Park (21.08)
- Couples Meeting (31.08)
- High Praise - Thanksgiving time (29.09)

Major project for 2025

- As a board of leadership, we are planning to run a food bank for the disadvantaged people in Cliffe Village and surrounding areas.
- We expect more families to join the church 2025.
- We expect more young adults to join the Praise and Worship.

Funding: Please see our financial report below.

Our main bill is the rent for the building we meet in. The monthly bill comes to £190 for Hall rentals. The bill can be higher if we book practice sessions for our Praise and Worship Team.

Other bills include booking spaces for our conferences and youth trips. For example, this year we ran an Easter Conference and we also had a Youth + Sunday School trip to Thorpe Park. We also subsidized the Thorpe Park trip for our members using the church account. All these costs will be added to our annual bill.

For us to run the church services, we need a working P.A system, microphone, projector (and screen), and instruments. Our members donate money in the form of Tithes and Offerings. If you would like more details on our finances, please refer to our annual return report uploaded on this platform.
