OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

The objects of the CIO are to advance in life and relieve needs of socially and economically disadvantaged young people aged 0 to 11 in England including (but not limited to) those attending Collingwood Primary School, so as to develop their capabilities that they may grow to full maturity as individuals and members of society in particular, but not exclusively by:

- (a) educating young persons who are pupils at schools by ensuring that due attention is given to the physical education of such pupils as well as to the development and occupation of their minds and with a view to furthering that object to provide funds and to assist in the organisation and provision of facilities which will enable and encourage such pupils to participate in recreation;
- (b) in the interests of social welfare to organise or provide facilities for recreation for persons who by reason of their youth or social and economic circumstances have need of such facilities;
- (c) to help young people who face complex transitions to adulthood. including (but not exclusively) those young people who are socially excluded or marginalised; and
- (d) such other objects and purposes in England being objects and purposes exclusively charitable in accordance with the laws of England and Wales.

Public benefit statement



Basis of preparing the financial statements

The financial statements of the charitable company, which is a public benefit entity under FRS 102, have been prepared in accordance with the Charities SORP (FRS 102) 'Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2019)', Financial Reporting Standard 102 'The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland' and the Companies Act 2006. The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

Income

All income is recognised in the Statement of Financial Activities once the charity has entitlement to the funds, it is probable that the income will be received and the amount can be measured reliably.

Expenditure

Liabilities are recognised as expenditure as soon as there is a legal or constructive obligation committing the charity to that expenditure, it is probable that a transfer of economic benefits will be required in settlement and the amount of the obligation can be measured reliably. Expenditure is accounted for on an accruals basis and has been classified under headings that aggregate all cost related to the category. Where costs cannot be directly attributed to particular headings they have been allocated to activities on a basis consistent with the use of resources.
