**Governing Document and Constitution**

The Charity is a Charitable Incorporated Organisation (CIO).

It was as registered as a charity with the Charity Commission on 27<sup>th</sup> April 2023.

**Trustees recruitment and appointment**

The Charity must have a least 10 Trustees with a maximum number of 12.

Apart from the first Trustees, every Trustee must be appointed by a resolution passed at a properly convened meeting of the Trustees, and are expected to serve a minimum of three years from date of appointment.

In selecting individuals for appointment as charity trustees, the existing Trustees must have regard to the skills, knowledge and experience needed for effective administration of the Charity.

#### OBJECTIVES

The objects of the CIO are for public benefit:

1. To help young people, especially but not exclusively through leisure activities, so as to develop their capabilities that they may grow to full maturity as individuals and members of society.


