I am going to be providing hot meals and will also look to distribute food Parcels for the less fortunate struggling and needy families.

I am also going to be providing free furniture to families in need when they move into their new homes. This will be items such as beds, fridges and cookers etc. I will have a launch for when I have my new venue and once I have the venue, I will then aim to raise money by doing events to engage the families in the community and also a way of raising funds for the charity too. I would also like to help the families be able to get out more to help them with social and interactive skills and help build their confidence by looking at arranging day trips.
