GOVERNANCE, MANAGEMENT AND PURPOSES

Governing Documents

Rochdale Evangelical Church was established as a CIO on 12th July 2023. The charity is governed by a constitution and church handbook, adopted by the members on 12th July 2023.

Aims & Purposes

The aims and purposes of the charity are outlined in the church constitution as:

1. The advancement of the Christian faith in accordance with the Basis of Faith primarily but not exclusively within Rochdale and the surrounding neighbourhood; and
2. such other charitable purposes as shall, in the opinion of the charity trustees, put into practice the Christian faith in accordance with the Basis of Faith, including but not limited to: the prevention and relief of need, hardship and sickness; the advancement of education; and the provision of facilities in the interests of social welfare for recreation or other leisure time occupation of individuals who have need of such facilities by reason of their youth, age infirmity or disability, financial hardship or social circumstances with the object of improving their conditions of life

provided that the advancement of such purposes must be undertaken in a manner that is consistent with the Doctrinal Distinctives and Ethical Statements as may be adopted and amended by the Church from time to time in accordance with the provisions of the Church Handbook.

Recruitment and Appointment of Trustees

The trustees of the charity are all the persons appointed to the offices of Pastor, Elder or Deacon. In accordance with the charity constitution and handbook, trustees are appointed by a vote of the church membership. All trustees are members of the charity.

There must always be at least three charity trustees. Currently there are four

Trustees meet together on a quarterly basis and present the results of such meetings at quarterly members' meetings. The trustees are responsible for ensuring the charitable purposes of the CIO are carried out in accordance with the church constitution and handbook.

Financial Review

Through the giving of charity members, the support of external partners - including churches, funding organisations and individuals – along with existing funds from the previous year, Rochdale Evangelical Church held funds totalling £38,021 on 31st December 2023.

Total unrestricted funds at the end of 2023 were £38,021

Total expenditure for the period 12th July – 31st December 2023 was £3,595

The results for the year show a surplus of income of £36,896

Plans for the future

The charity will continue to seek support through membership giving and building partnership with external individuals, churches and funding organisations in order to advance its aims and objectives.

- select suitable accounting policies and apply them consistently;

- prepare the financial statements on a going concern basis unless it is inappropriate to presume that the charity will continue in existence.
