Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the year

The charity has experienced a change in its programme and projects – the goal remains the same.

Construction work had begun on a site in October 2024 to refurbish and convert an old building into a gym. However, this consumed finances and the business plan reviewed by trustees proved this would not be financially sustainable.

Parallel to the build the Patron Terry and the trustees were keen to work with more children in the community.

Sessions at NYCC continued and new sessions were introduced in primary schools coaching small groups of year 6 pupils. At the end of the academic year July 2025 the pupils Ignite Foundation had introduced to boxing exercise sessions had turned a leaf in their behaviour and learning. Teachers and parents were delighted by the positive impact these sessions had on the young students.

Ignite Foundation ceased the gym project and rolled out a new programme which takes boxing exercise session directly to the young people. Working with primary schools the sessions are offered for free to Schools in the Enfield Borough. This change in focus highlighted the public benefit to bringing free boxing to schools that are under resourced, provide children access to free fitness, improving their mental and physical health.

Trustees agreed that this was a more sustainable project that would have a direct impact that would benefit the community.

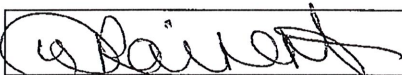

- Wednesday 01 November 2023 - Patron Terry Mordecai organized a sponsor event, where he gathered local businesses, community organisations and local authorities to bring the charity and its aims to their attention. This event raised the charities profile, there was no fundraising at this event. The supporters have offered their material/labour for the building of the gym.
- Sunday 12th November 2023 Football Fundraiser – a local club organized a charity football match with a raffle and auction. All funds raised were donated to Ignite Foundation via a Go Fund Me charity page. Raffle and Auction prizes were donated from the football club and community.
- December 2023 Application for Planning Permission submitted. Local Authorities rejected and delayed this until Summer 2024.
- January – Spring 2024 surveys and quotes gathered for ground works, Thames water connection and electrics. Sponsors have been updated along the way, with expectations of when work will begin and what work will need to be done.

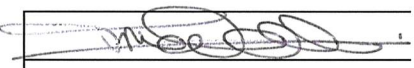
