New team kits were purchased for playing members of the 1st, 2nd and 3rd XI football teams, thanks in part to sponsorship funding from Footboard. At the Southern Amateur League's end of season awards dinner, the club were proud to be announced as winners of the Wilkinson Sword trophy, awarded to the club with the best discipline record and sportsmanship scores throughout the season.

Four teams were entered to compete in the Southern Amateur League and several cup competitions, including the AFA Cup and the Old Boys Cup, enabling registered members to participate in a total of 79 matches across the season. The Third XI football team reached the club's first ever cup final, which was a stunning achievement and fostered a great deal of enthusiasm, engagement and pride amongst all members of the club. A new benefactor, Footboard, became a sponsor of Old Blues Association Football Club, providing a donation of £500 to be applied towards the provision of new team kits for playing members.

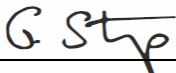

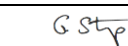
