Objectives and Activities

The purposes of the methodist church are and shall be deemed to have been since the date of union the advancement of (a) the christian faith in accordance with the doctrinal standards and the discipline of the methodist church; (b) any charitable purpose for the time being of any connexional, district, circuit, local or other organisation of the methodist church; (c) any charitable purpose for the time being of any society or institution subsidiary or ancillary to the methodist church; (d) any purpose for the time being of any charity being a charity subsidiary or ancillary to the methodist church.

The Church has maintained worship services on Sunday Mornings and a monthly service on Sunday evening. Support has continued to the local primary school through our Bags of Help scheme. Weekday activities have continued for Children through Toast and First Steps. Junior Church has continued on a Sunday morning. Community groups continue to hire the halls.

The trustees have complied with the duty in section 4 of the 2011 Charities Act to have due regard to guidance published by the Charity Commission, including public benefit guidance. The trustees have referred to the Charity Commission's general guidance on public benefit when reviewing the charity's aims and objectives and in planning future activities.

Achievements and Performance

The church has worship services at 10.30am every Sunday and these are broadcast to the internet. There is a healing service at 6.30pm on the third Sunday of the month. Refreshments are provided for all in the Hall following the morning service.

Junior Church is provided during the 10.30am services for all children, attending the first part of the service before moving to the Church Hall.

Eight fellowship groups meet fortnightly in various locations and at various times of day and evening

Other groups which meet and include members from outside the church:

The Women's Fellowship meets on Wednesday afternoons in term time

First Steps, for parents and children under school age – an ecumenical group meets fortnightly.

Toast Club, for primary school children is held fortnightly during term time in the church hall.

Two Alpha courses were run.

Weekly prayer meetings were held using Zoom. Other types of prayer were run including a day of prayer and a monthly prayer meeting in Church.

Who Let the Dads Out, a monthly meeting for Dads and male carers with primary age and younger children.

Carpenter's Arms a men's group meets occasionally.

Money was raised to support Christian Aid, All We Can and Tear Fund.

Cook continue to supply meals to be distributed to those in need. The School continue to identify families in need of groceries.

We now supply up to five families once a fortnight during term time.

Financial Review

The total receipts of the charity amounted to £90,247 with payments of £121,792 (2024: total receipts of £110,228 with payments of £155,112).

Reserves Policy

The policy of the charity as at 31 August 2025 was to have free reserves of £63,000 to fund its work. Unrestricted funds at 31 August 2025 were £39,792 (2024: £71,256) with no restricted funds. As at 31 August 2025 the assets of the charity are not considered to be adequate to fulfil its obligations and the trustees will plan how to raise the shortfall as the church will continue.

Structure, Governance & Management

The charity is an unincorporated charity governed by the Deed of Union (1932) and Methodist Church Act (1976) adopted 26 October 1976. The charity was registered with the Charity Commission on 9 August 2023.
