Our collection is the first of its kind in the region and currently includes hard and digital archival materials and oral histories of several key local Global Majority organisations.

Due to a Trustee member stepping down after our first AGM, and the limited capacity of setting up the new CIO off the ground, there has been a halt in activities.

We submitted for a Resilience Grant to the National Archives in January 2024 but it was unsuccessful.

We advertised for an admin worker and a recruitment interview was carried out in December 2023, but no candidate was appointable.
