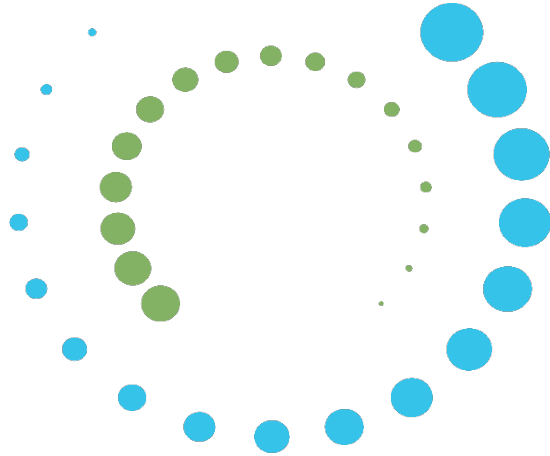

FINANCIAL REVIEW

Total income for the period was £2,663 consisting of earned income from the Classic Ibiza event held at Bowood House, Wiltshire, August 2024 and a Charity Quiz night held locally.

Expenditure for the period was £1,324.60 for festival items which was sold at the above-mentioned event.

By 31 of December 2024, the balance of our funds was £9,288.80.


TRUSTEES RESPONSIBILITIES
