**Objects:** THE OBJECTS OF THE CIO ARE FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE PUBLIC WITHIN THE AREA OF BENEFIT AND INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING:(A) THE RELIEF OF POVERTY OR HARDSHIP BY THE PROVISION AND MAINTENANCE OF ALMSHOUSE ACCOMMODATION; AND(B) SUCH CHARITABLE PURPOSES FOR THE BENEFIT OF RESIDENTS OF THE ALMSHOUSES AS THE TRUSTEES SHALL IN THEIR ABSOLUTE DISCRETION THINK FIT INCLUDING THE PROVISION OF FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO CURRENT RESIDENTS WHO ARE IN NEED.RESIDENTS OF THE ALMSHOUSES SHALL BE PERSONS OF 50 YEARS OF AGE OR MORE WHO, PRIOR TO THEIR APPOINTMENT, ARE RESIDENT IN OR CAN DEMONSTRATE A STRONG CONNECTION WITH THE AREA OF BENEFIT AND ARE IN SUFFICIENT NEED OR HARDSHIP WHICH REQUIRES SUPPORT.IN THIS CONSTITUTION, THE EXPRESSION 'AREA OF BENEFIT' SHALL MEAN THE PARISHES OF DEBDEN AND WIMBISH, NEAR SAFFRON WALDON IN ESSEX.IF, AFTER THREE MONTHS OF ADVERTISING A VACANCY, THE CHARITY TRUSTEES HAVE BEEN UNABLE TO IDENTIFY A SUITABLE CANDIDATE TO BE A BENEFICIARY AND RESIDENT, THE CHARITY TRUSTEES MAY, FOR THE PURPOSES OF THE VACANCY IN QUESTION, AND AT THEIR ABSOLUTE DISCRETION, DISREGARD THE 50 YEARS OF AGE OR MORE RESTRICTION AND/OR EXTEND THE AREA OF BENEFIT TO SURROUNDING PARISHES.RESIDENTS WILL BE REQUESTED TO MAKE A REASONABLE FINANCIAL CONTRIBUTION, BASED ON THEIR INDIVIDUAL MEANS.

### **Report of the Trustees for the year ended 31 December 2024**

The Bathurst Charity (“the Charity”) was registered on 15 August 2023, with the Constitution of a Charitable Incorporated Organisation. During the year, pursuant to Orders of the Charity Commission for England and Wales, the Charity assumed the assets and undertaking of three unincorporated charities – The Bathurst Charity (registered No. 209710); Dr Carter’s Charity (registered No. 208251), and The Charity of John Measant (registered No. 208250). This report covers the activities of all these charities during the year, and financial information has been prepared on the basis of merger accounting.

#### **Objects and activities of the Charity.**

The Bathurst Charity was established in 1868, to acquire and administer properties in the Parish of Debden, Essex as almshouses.

The objects of the Charity are for the benefit of the public within the parishes of Debden and Wimbish, near Saffron Walden in Essex, and include the relief of poverty or hardship by the

provision and maintenance of almshouse accommodation. Residents of the almshouses are beneficiaries of the Charity, not tenants, and pay maintenance contributions, not rent. Maintenance contributions are reviewed by the Trustees annually.

The almshouses comprise four units – two single and two double occupancy – and during the year provided housing for four people, one of the single units being unoccupied pending refurbishment. During the year, the Charity has carried out any necessary maintenance work on the properties, and has developed plans for a major refurbishment of the two single units.

**Public benefit.**

The Trustees have had due regard to the Charity Commission's Public Benefit Guidance when exercising any powers or duties to which the guidance is relevant.

**Reserves policy.**

The policy of the Trustees is to ensure that the Charity has sufficient free reserves to meet current and foreseeable obligations. As at 31 December 2024, the Charity had free reserves of £28,661, and unrestricted reserves designated for future property maintenance of £14,075.
