The charity's objectives are to supply and develop the sport of powerchair football worldwide, supporting member nations and promoting participation, inclusivity, and competitive excellence.

Achievements and Performance

During the financial year, the charity successfully organised the European Champions Cup and supported development initiatives across member countries. The organisation also delivered various clinics to improve coaching, refereeing, and classification standards internationally.

Plans for the Future

In 2025, the charity aims to coordinate World Cup qualifying tournaments across Europe, America, and Asia. Additional goals include hosting the World Club Cup and expanding training programmes for coaches, referees, and classifiers to strengthen the sport globally.

Opening Balance £73,681. The charity's total income for the year was £61,394, with total expenditure of £42,335, resulting in a closing balance of £106,504. Funds are managed prudently to ensure the continued development of powerchair football worldwide.
