1. Objectives and Activities

The Jalalpur Advancement Committee UK (JAC UK) is a Charitable Incorporated Organisation (CIO) established to advance people's welfare, education, and health in Jalalpur, Bangladesh. Our activities focus on supporting underprivileged communities through direct aid and community-led initiatives.

2. Public Benefit

The trustees confirm that they have complied with their duty under section 17(5) of the Charities Act 2011 to have due regard to the public benefit guidance published by the Charity Commission.

3. Achievements and Performance

During this financial year, the charity provided community aid in Jalalpur, Bangladesh. Key achievements include:

- Delivery of £3,040 in charitable assistance abroad.
- Support was funded entirely through public donations.

4. Financial Review

- **Total income:** £3,310 (entirely from donations)
- **Total spending:** £3,040 (all for charitable activities)
- **Surplus carried forward:** £270

5. Structure, Governance, and Management

The charity is a Charitable Incorporated Organisation (CIO), governed by its constitution. It is managed by a board of trustees who met regularly and administered funds accordingly.

At the time of reporting, the charity does not have a formal reserves policy but plans to establish one in the next financial year.
