- To promote humane behaviour towards animals by providing appropriate care, protection, treatment and security for animals which are in need of care and attention by reason of sickness, maltreatment, poor circumstances or ill usage and to educate the public in matters pertaining to animal welfare in general and the prevention of cruelty and suffering among animals.

During the year, the Charity has undertaken the following activities for the public benefit:

- Taking ownership of unwanted or stray animals
- Providing medical treatment and caring for animals until suitable homes are available and if not, providing suitable shelter for them until they are ready to go to a new home
- Trapping animals for neutering purposes if in feral colonies
