Trustees' Annual Report

During the year, the trustees of *Hope into Action West Kent and Medway* have undertaken a period of review and reflection regarding the future direction of the charity.

Due to unforeseen circumstances, the trustees have decided not to continue operating under the support and framework of the wider charity *Hope into Action (UK)*. The trustees are currently exploring alternative partnerships to continue the vision of providing housing and support to those in need within the Kent and Medway area.

To this end, no income or expenditure has been recorded during the financial year. The charity has remained dormant whilst these discussions and strategic considerations have taken place.

In order to prevent any confusion with the national charity and to reflect the new direction, the trustees have resolved to change the name of the charity to **Waymaker Housing Trust Kent and Medway** with effect from **29 October 2025**.

The trustees remain committed to the charity's underlying purpose — to offer hope and a home to those experiencing housing insecurity — and will continue to seek appropriate partnerships and resources to fulfil this aim under the new name.
