Summary of the purposes of the charity as set out in its governing document	Para 1.17	Insulinoma Charity UK exists to relieve sickness and preserve health by supporting people affected by insulinoma and related neuroendocrine tumours. The charity aims to raise awareness of insulinoma, improve understanding of the condition among patients, families, and professionals, and provide information, advocacy, and support to those impacted. The charity also seeks to promote education and public awareness of rare endocrine conditions to improve diagnosis, care, and outcomes.
Summary of the main activities in relation to those purposes for the public benefit, in particular, the activities, projects or services identified in the accounts.	Para 1.17 and 1.19	During the period, the charity focused on awareness raising, patient support, and information sharing. Activities included providing guidance and signposting to individuals affected by insulinoma, sharing lived experience stories to improve public and professional understanding, and supporting families navigating complex diagnostic and treatment pathways. The charity also engaged with patients and carers to reduce isolation and ensure that accurate, accessible information about insulinoma was available to those who need it.

The activities undertaken during the period were carried out to benefit people affected by insulinoma and the wider public by increasing awareness of a rare condition, supporting informed decision making, and promoting earlier recognition and understanding of symptoms.

The charity supported individuals and families during diagnosis and treatment, shared personal stories to raise awareness of rare disease impact, and helped reduce isolation for those affected. The work undertaken contributed to greater understanding of insulinoma and highlighted the real-world challenges faced by patients and carers.
