With funding available and a track record of support, as well as an understanding of the charity's position and objectives, the trustees expect to be able to open partnerships with third-party organisations in order to begin applying funds to the intended charitable purposes.</p>

However, the trustees expect progress to be made now that the charity's funding position is more secure.</p>


