Odyssey Girls Charity is governed by its Constitution and operates in accordance with the requirements of the Charity Commission for England and Wales.

Objectives and Activities

The charity was established to advance education and life opportunities for girls from disadvantaged backgrounds through educational support, sponsorship, and access to learning resources.

During the reporting period, the charity focused on foundational and preparatory work. This included developing sponsorship frameworks, safeguarding approaches, selection criteria, and engagement with schools and families. No direct charitable expenditure was incurred during this period as activities were at a planning stage.

Public Benefit

The trustees have had due regard to Charity Commission guidance on public benefit. The groundwork undertaken supports the future delivery of educational benefits to girls who may otherwise face barriers to learning.

Financial Review

Total income for the period amounted to £5,100, comprising donations which can be evidenced via the charity's bank account.

Total expenditure for the period was £0. No costs were charged to the charity. The trustee personally met initial and preparatory costs and deliberately chose not to expense these to the charity.

Reserves Policy

Funds held at the period end are retained to support the commencement of charitable programmes in future periods.

Plans for Future Periods

The charity intends to commence direct educational support, implement monitoring frameworks, and deploy charitable funds in line with its objectives.
