Objectives and Activities

Summary of the purposes of the charity as set out in its governing document.	1) To provide relief to those in need due to finding themselves homeless within Wales in particular by: a) Providing safe and secure accommodation. b) Assisting with integration of those in need back into the community and independent living. c) Providing clothing, sleeping bags and other essential items to those who have been sleeping rough/on the streets. 2) The relief of sickness of those whose mental health has been affected due to the trauma of homelessness by the provision of counselling and other therapies of proven benefit. 3) The relief of poverty or financial hardship by the provision of a food bank that is accessible by those who are vulnerable due to ill health, poverty, financial hardship and other such means as defined by the trustees.
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Summary of the main activities in relation to those purposes for the public benefit, in particular, the activities, projects or services identified in the accounts.	The trustees have had difficulty in identifying a suitable piece of land to lease for the provision of object 1.
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Achievements and Performance

The CIO has formed a positive relationship with the local Cricket Club, who have donated a space specifically for the food bank for free.

Review of the charity's financial position at the end of the period.	The CIO finished the year in a strong position. Heading into the busiest period for the food bank, winter and the financial restraints of Christmas, there was a healthy sum available to trustees, before any further donations were received.
Statement explaining the policy for holding reserves stating why they are held.	Trustees believe that a cash reserve of £1000.00 in unrestricted cash is prudent to allow for any unexpected costs that may arise or any emergency support that may be requested.

Explanation of any uncertainties about the charity continuing as a going concern.	There are no financial concerns regarding the charity's continuation and reserves remain healthy. However, the Criddle family have just lost Paul Criddle, a trustee and James' father. Paul was not only a trustee but one of the key volunteers and very much at the heart of the charity. This loss to the charity may see the charity scale back any progression plans for a period of time.
