SIGNPOSTING THE BENEFICIARIES TO ALL OF THE RELEVANT INFORMATION THEY NEED DURING THEIR TIME IN THE UK, SUCH AS INFORMATION IN RELATION TO RECRUITMENT, BENEFITS, HOUSING, EDUCATION AND SIGNPOSTING TO MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES.

We combat local poverty, isolation, and depression, all powered by a unique pay-it-forward volunteer model. Volunteers from local Schools, colleges and SEND provisions supporting those in need of community.
