All Stars After-School and Holiday Club is located in Ysgol Maes Y Mynydd Rhosllanerchrugog Wrexham. Most of our children come from the school but a few come from the local area.

All Stars is registered with The Care Inspectorate Wales (CIW).

According to the requirements laid down by the children's act 1989. The setting is fully insured and run by experienced, qualified staff on a minimum ratio of 1:8 for children 3-11 years.

The All Stars is registered to take 25 children.

There are 9 members of staff, mostly working part time.

The children are cared for and supervised by English speaking staff, however we do endeavour to incorporate the Welsh language where possible.

We are based in a classroom within the infant part of the school.

During term-time the After-School Club is open from 3:15pm – 5:30 pm.

Holiday Club is open from 8:30am – 5:30pm during school holidays.

Half day cover is also provided.

The club also offers full day care on most school inset days which is 8:30am – 5:30pm.

Both boys and girls between the ages of 3 –11 years are cared for in a safe and stimulating environment until collected and signed out by a parent, guardian or another nominated adult known to the staff.

Wages Minimum wage increased by nearly £1 an hour

The yearly wages budget increased by £5000 from £30000 to £35000.

The group like to keep a higher staff ratio for good practice particularly in holiday club as we are busy.


Our budget for external providers and Rental equipment remand the same £2000. This pays for (e.g.) magicians, disco, bouncy castle.

Our budget for toys increased to £1000 from £500 the year before

The setting has seen an increase in confidence in children coming to back to us this year.

As we approach the summer break, with Holiday Club proving very popular, a number of pre-bookings been taken for the summer. We are also looking at providing much lower costing activities when we work alongside another summer playgroup scheme.

Aims and Objectives

At All Stars we aim to provide affordable, accessible child care for children between the ages of 2-11years.

We aim to provide a happy, secure environment where children, parents, carers and staff feel welcome and valued.

Financial Status

We started the year with £9,847.95 and ended with £12,910.94

This year saw a large increase of income total £120,020

Our income was mainly from fees and 30 hours. Which increases to £73,881:

Flying start income was £22,200:

The grant of £12,268: went towards equipment and toys to make our new room suitable for the range of children.

Our outgoing all so increased total £116,957:

This was mainly due to the increase of wages £83,148:

Staff increases hours due to All Stars been open from 8 am till 17:30pm and we also took children from the age of 2 years. This means our child to adult ratio was 1:4 so we needed more staff to meet the legal requirements.

Food increased to £ 2,094: as we were preparing a variety of snacks which included fresh fruit and vegetables to meet the needs of the morning children who attend (Flying start children and playgroup)
