We focus on providing extra tuition in core GCSE subjects like Maths, English, and Science, and also offer adult classes in essential academic and computer skills."

Main Activities During the Year:

After-School Tutoring Sessions

- One-on-one and small group formats led by qualified volunteer tutors.

- Providing online classes via Zoom or Teams for students unable to attend in person.
- Digital literacy training for both young people and adults.
